
SUBLIMATION: NEW WORK BY DAVID MEYER

THE SKYBOX PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA MARCH 13-27, 2010


















Sublimation, a site-specific installation created at The Skybox in Philadelphia as an Independent Project for the city-wide international contemporary art event, Philagrafika 2010. Curator Eileen Tognini invited Meyer to utilize the enormous open space of the gallery to create this monumental scale floor based installation from a thousand pounds of sifted flour.

For David Meyer, creating a tangible interpretation of memories becomes the dialogue between comprehension and experience. The exploration of memory and its distortion becomes a mediated process Meyer expresses through the transformation of photographic images into sculptures, akin to typesetting, Braille, newspaper print, pixilated imagery -- each holding a different image for each viewer -- referencing their own memory and reality.
